

## 📅 Course Outline

### Day 1

- Group pick-up in San Jose (10 am)
- Welcome meeting with guides who will introduce themselves and provide an overview of the retreat.
- Lunch on the way
- Guided tour of the village, important landmarks such as rivers and mountains.
- Afternoon relaxation and group dinner with local cuisine.

### Day 2

- Guided tour of a coffee plantation, coffee picking, and learning about the harvesting process.

### Day 3

- Session on roasting techniques and coffee packaging.
- Tasting of local coffees
- Lunch with traditional Costa Rican dishes prepared by local cooks.
- Soccer match.

### Day 4

- Morning cooking class to learn how to prepare traditional Costa Rican dishes.
- Visit to a nearby farm or plantation to learn about agricultural practices, citrus harvesting, and packaging.

### Day 5

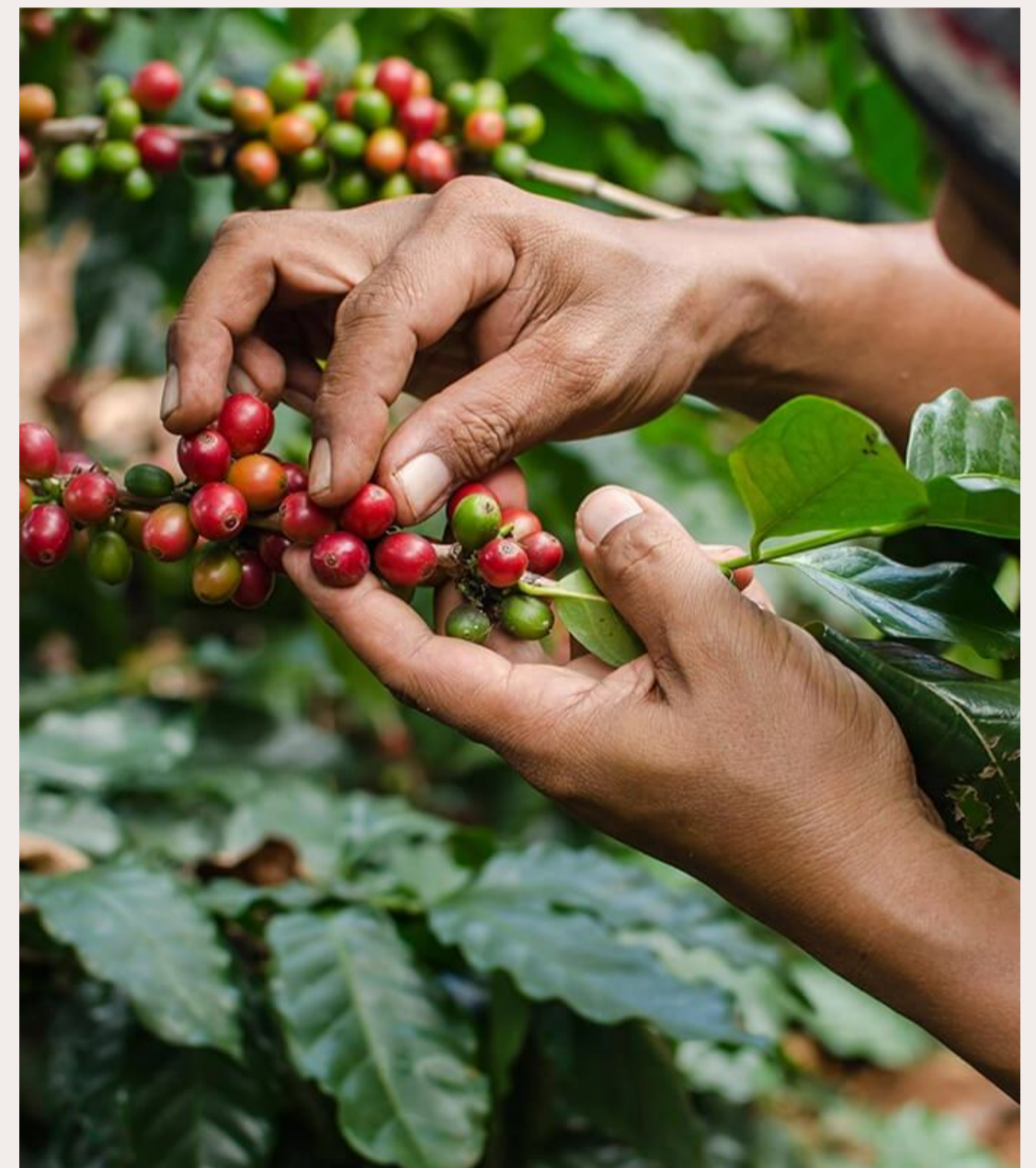
- Guided birdwatching hike with outdoor breakfast (6 am)
